Looking back at the 33rd NKRV Workshop on February 9th 2024 at the Nuclear Research Group in Petten. For the third time we had our NKRV meeting in Petten, which was hosted by NRG. After the security check, the workshop took place in the auditorium. Approximately 130 participants registered for the workshop, from all corners of the Netherlands and Belgium and from different disciplines, like chemistry, biology, pharmacy.

This was followed by a plenary lecture given by the host dr. Karlijn van de Schilden on radionuclide production and the new FieldLab facilities. After a nice lunch there were round table discussions on GMP Annex-1 and and Alpha Radiochemistry. For those who registered early, there was also the possibility for a guided tour to the high flux reactor, the hot cells, or the FieldLab. In the afternoon there were 5 excellent PhD research presentations on very diverse topics demonstrating the multidisciplinarity of our society. The meeting was closed with drinks and bites.

We want to thank all participants for their contributions and the NRG team for being so kind to host us. We are happy to see so many enthusiastic young researchers in our field of radiochemistry.

News about Clinical Radiochemist

Erik de Blois, Danielle Vugts, Alex Poot and Gert Luurtsema re-initiated the recognition of Clinical Radiochemists. This is supported by Philip Elsinga and Bert Windhorst, as former NKRV board members and founders of the Clinical Radiochemist initiative.



A letter aimed to recognize the profession "Clinical Radiochemist" has been sent to other professional groups like the NVNG (nuclear physician) and the NVZA (hospital pharmacist) and will be discussed soon with these professionals groups.

In the meantime the NKRV board installed a work-group to define the competences of a clinical radiochemist, what is required to obtain this certificate, and what is required to keep and renew this.

Travel grants



In 2024 there is budget for 10 travel grants in total. Per travel grant the amount is set at maximum 500 euro pp. It will allow for the reimbursement of registration costs for symposia and conference related travel expenses. The requirements are: you are a member of NKRV (attended at least one workshop in the past year); you are a technician, PhD student or Postdoc working in our field; and you received no other (travel)grants. You can apply for an NKRV travel grant once every three years.

- If you want to apply for a travel grant send an email to info@nkrv.nl to request the form for the travel grant. Hereafter send this form back together with:
- Proof of submission and acceptance of abstract (poster or oral)
- Letter of supervisor stating that you are a PhD student or technician in the research group of the supervisor
- Proof of payment (will be sent in afterwards)
